

DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE UNDER SADDLE RULES 2005 (Class 92 & 107)

PURPOSE: To evaluate potential, suitability and qualities as a dressage sport horse.

1. Open to Morgan Stallions, Mares, and Gelding 3 years old or older as of January 1, 2004.
2. A horse may be disqualified for unsoundness. In Dressage Sport Horse Under Saddle classes unsoundness is defined as showing evidence of lameness. Horses showing complete loss of sight in either eye are permitted to compete without penalty.
3. The class may be divided at the Judges discretion.
4. Braiding is optional.
5. Dress must conform to USA Equestrian Article 1920, and Saddlery and Equipment must conform to Article 1921, Except that all horses are required to compete in a snaffle pictured in Rule XIX, Chapter 1 figure 1A.
6. Bandages of any kind are forbidden during a class.
7. If the schedule permits management may allow time for questions from competitors to the judge at the end of the show.
8. Horses will be judged for conformation while standing in line under tack and rider.
9. The judge will judge the classes with the scoresheets as a guideline --- however to be able to run the class in a timely manner no actual scoresheets will be recorded.
