



Maine Morgan Horse Club, Inc.

Nicole White & Christopher Vose Scholarship

The Maine Morgan Horse Club provides one or two scholarships each year to an outstanding young man or woman who will be or is already attending a post high school program.

Applications are being accepted for the 2010 scholarship. Applications must be postmarked no later than May 1, 2010.

The following are the guidelines on which the scholarship(s) will be granted:

1. \$1000 in scholarship money will be available annually. The Club may award one \$1000 scholarship or two \$500 scholarships.
2. The recipient(s) will be announced at the Maine Morgan Horse Show in July.
3. The scholarship program is open to any young man or woman (under 22 years old) who is or will be a high school graduate and is a member in good standing of the Maine Morgan Horse Club, Inc.
4. The following criteria will be considered important in selecting the recipient: the applicant's involvement in the AMHA HorseMastership program or the 4H/FFA program; the applicant's ability and aptitude for a serious study; community service; leadership; achievement with horses and financial need.
5. The scholarship will be paid directly to a college or university, trade school or vocational training program within two years after the award of the scholarship. Upon receipt of the award, a written request from the recipient must be made for payment to the designated school.
6. Previous winners of this scholarship are ineligible to participate a second time. Previous applicants who did not win the scholarship may re-apply.
7. Applications and three (3) letters of reference relative to applicant's character, abilities and achievement, with a copy of the applicant's most recent transcript from high school and/or school in attendance at the time of application must be postmarked no later than May 1, 2010 and sent to the Scholarship chair.
8. If, in the opinion of the Scholarship Committee, no applicants meet the standards as set by the Committee, the scholarship funds will be held within the Maine Morgan Horse Club, Inc. scholarship account until such applicant is found.
