MOVEMENT: WALK & FREE WALK Four even beats, straight and even strides, correctly aligned steps, articulation of joints, freedom of shoulders and haunches, balance, elastic & swinging back, overstep, reach, ground –covering with marching quality	Purity and Quality (judged mainly in profile). MOVEMENT: TROT & LENGTHENED TROT Two even beats, straight and even strides, correctly aligned steps, articulation of joints, freedom of shoulders & haunches, balance, elasticity, swinging back, natural engagement and impulsion from hindquarters, suspension, power from upward thrust and roundness	Purity and Quality (judged mainly in profile). Correctness (judged mainly coming and going from judge). Movement should be big, light and springy.			X 2.0 or 20%	
MOVEMENT: CANTER & MAY BE ASKED TO LENGTHEN Three even beats, straight and even strides, correctly aligned steps, articulation of joints, freedom of shoulders & haunches, balance, elasticity, swinging back, natural engagement and impulsion from hindquarters, suspension, power from upward thrust, roundness & “uphill” strides	Purity and Quality (judged mainly in profile). Correctness (judged mainly coming and going from judge). Movement should be big, light and springy.			X 2.0 Or 20%	
GENERAL IMPRESSION: Includes Impulsion, balance and rideability. Alert, expressive & well-mannered (including square HALT)	Riding horse type			X 1.0 Or 10%
